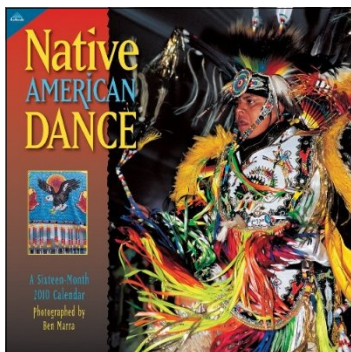

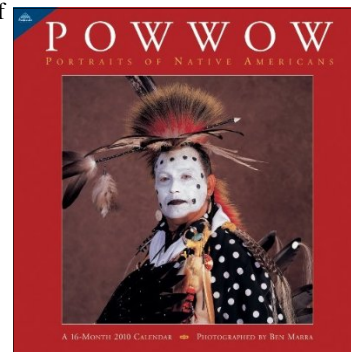

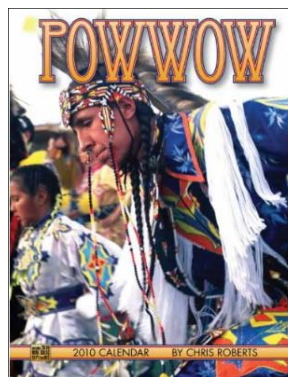


POW WOW - Photographs by Chris Roberts

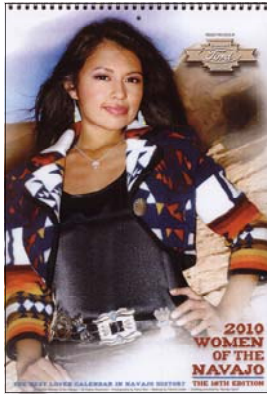

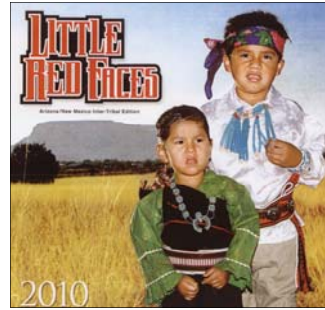

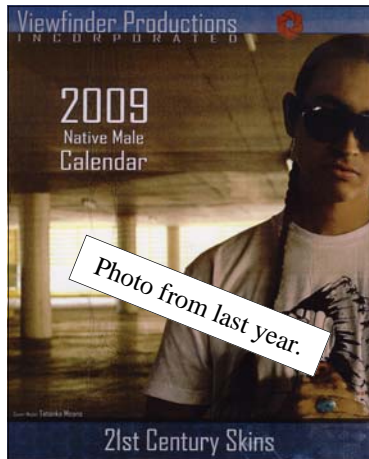
